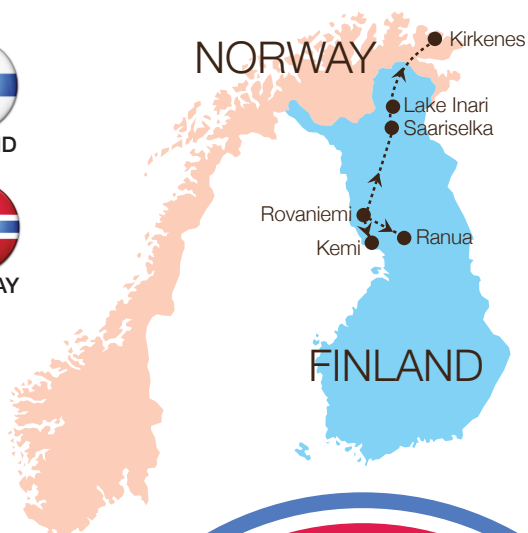

NORWAY – KIRKENES

- **King Crab Safari with Snowmobile Sleigh Ride + Enjoy “THE BEST OF NORWEGIAN SET LUNCH SEAFOOD”** - A totally unforgettable experience awaits you on the frozen fjords of Kirkenes. This is your chance to eat this mysterious creature. Although presentation is simple, the superb white leg meat and claws, with their particularly juicy and naturally sweet taste, make this meal in a league of its own.

Note: : You will head out to the fjord either by snowmobile sleigh or boat accompany by experienced staff. They will demonstrate of pulling crab cage & you will have an option to take photograph with King Crab. (subject to weather conditions)

- **Aurora Borealis** - is a beautiful and mysterious natural phenomenon that occurs when solar winds interact with the Earth's magnetic field, causing high-energy electrons and ions to enter the Earth's atmosphere and collide with gas molecules, releasing energy and producing brilliant lights. The best season for the Aurora Borealis is from Sep till Apr with the most frequent sightings occurring between 6pm to 1am.

The opportunity to witness this visual wonder of nature, it is subjected on weather conditions such as solar activity, cloud cover and other factors and cannot be guaranteed. However, sighting is not confined to this schedule as the "dancing green lights" may show up randomly during your stay in Lapland.

Tour Manager will guide customer where to view the Aurora – it can be surrounding hotel area by walking distance.

Note : Aurora Borealis is a natural phenomenon, Golden Destinations unable to guarantee the appearance of during your visit at anytime.

- **Snow Hotel** - is situated 8km outside Kirkenes in the secluded wilds of Northern Norway since 2006. Dreamlike rooms uniquely carved by master ice sculptors from around the world. Hotel is built completely of snow and ice, and each spring melts back into the fjord. Snowhotel is one of the most famous igloo hotels in Norway, and in the world.

- **Husky Dog Farm** - also known as the Polar husky, is Lapland's most heartfelt friend. Visit the huskies Farm to learn about their daily routines and training. Husky sledding is a truly thrilling and memorable experience.
- **Ice Fishing Safari Experience** - Rovaniemi in Lapland, Finland, a true Finnish experience is ice fishing. An activity that can be experienced a new skill of ice fishing on river ice or on wilderness lake's ice.
- **Arktikum Science Museum** - is a science center and museum that lets you experience northern nature, culture, and history up close. - **Arctic Science Museum** - visit to Lapland's finest museum, Arktikum to enjoy an interactive lesson on Lappish history and culture and take a stroll in the museum's gorgeous glass gallery.
- **Lampivaara Amethyst Mine + Amethyst Pendolino Ride** - Enjoy a thrilling Amethyst Pendolino ride to the top of Lampivaara hill for mesmerising Lapland landscape views and visit Lampivaara Amethyst Mine to experience digging for the purple quartz, the Lapland's precious jewels.
- **Snow Mobile Experience to Reindeer Farm Safari Ride** - Experience to drive snowmobile on the frozen sea and visit the local reindeer farm with safari ride.

The zoo's animals consist of approximately 50 wild animal species and 200 individuals, including top predators such as lynx, brown bears and wolves but also European moose and deers. The zoo has Finland's only polar bears in artificial snow.
