- **Mexico**, country of southern North America and the third largest country in Latin America, after Brazil and Argentina. Mexican society is characterized by extremes of wealth and poverty, with a limited middle class wedged between an elite cadre of landowners and investors on the one hand and masses of rural and urban poor on the other. But in spite of the challenges it faces as a developing country, Mexico is one of the chief economic and political forces in Latin America. It has a dynamic industrial base, vast mineral resources, a wide-ranging service sector, and the world's largest population of Spanish speakers—about two and a half times that of Spain or Colombia.
- **Teotihuacan** – Teotihuacan is an ancient Mesoamerican city located in a sub-valley of the Valley of Mexico, which is located in the State of Mexico, 40 kilometers (25 mi) northeast of modern-day Mexico City.
- **Puebla** – Puebla City which is the capital of the state of Puebla and the fourth largest city in Mexico. Puebla is a modern city, with rich history. The city is notable for its colonial architecture, gastronomy, and folk art – in particular the Talavera ceramics.
- **Palacio De Bellas Artes** – The Palacio de Bellas Artes, one of the Mexico City landmarks, It is a prominent cultural center in Mexico City. This hosts performing arts events, literature events and plastic arts galleries and exhibitions.

- **Rio Lagartos** – The pink lakes of Rio Lagartos in northern Yucatan was a place we found like most people, on Instagram. The crazy contrast between the amazingly pink water, the desolate landscape, and the perfect blue sky was too much to just scroll past and after a little more research we discovered the flamingos, crocodiles, turtles and various other birds and marine life, however, we were pretty much locked in at flamingos and pink water.
- **Las Coloradas** – Mexico is replete with incredible scenic wonders, but few sights are as unique and breathtaking as the pink lakes in Quintana Roo. Known locally as Las Coloradas ("blush red"), the cotton-candy-colored lakes attract tourists from all across the world. If you find yourself visiting the Cancún area or exploring the Riviera Maya, a short detour to Las Coloradas is well worth the journey.
- **TULUM** – Tulum is a town on the Caribbean coastline of Mexico's Yucatán Peninsula. It's known for its beaches and well-preserved ruins of an ancient Mayan port city.
