观光景点:

伦彭 **白金汉宫** - 白金汉宫是英国君主位于伦敦的主要寝宫及办公处。宫殿坐落在西敏市,是国家庆典和王 室欢迎礼举行场地之一,也是一处重要的旅游景点。

大本钟 – 大本钟是伦敦威斯敏斯特宫北端时钟大钟的昵称,通常指时钟和钟楼。该塔是伊丽莎白塔的 正式名称,2012年更名为庆祝伊丽V莎白二世的钻石禧年。

巴黎

- 原子塔 为1958年布鲁塞尔世博会建造的原子球塔,高102米,由ANDRÉ WATERKEYN设计,包含 9个直径18米的球体,模拟A铁晶体结构。三个球体对游客开放,顶部球体提供布鲁塞尔全景。
- 大广场 布鲁塞尔大广场是比利时首都布鲁塞尔的中心广场, 1998年被联合国教科文组织列为世界文 化遗产。始建于12世纪,广场长约110米、宽约60米,四周被中世纪行会建筑环绕。

- **海德堡城堡** 海德堡城堡位于德国南部,是阿尔卑斯山以北最著名的文艺复兴废墟建筑。坐落于80米 高的王座山坡北部、俯瞰老城区。

清清湖

LONDON

- **Buckingham Palace -** Buckingham Palace has served as the official London residence of the UK's sovereigns since 1837 and today is the administrative headquarters of the Monarch.
- Big Ben Big Ben refers to the Great Bell at the Palace of Westminster, often extending to the clock and its tower, officially named Elizabeth Tower in 2012 for Queen Elizabeth II's Diamond Jubilee.

- Place Charles de Gaulle. Known for its theatres, cafés, luxury shops, and the annual Bastille Day military parade. Champs Elysees - Is a boulevard in Paris's 8th arrondissement, runs from Place de la Concorde to

BRUSSELS

- Atomium The Atomium is a building in Brussels originally constructed for Expo 58, the 1958 Brussels World's Fair. Designed by the engineer André Waterkeyn and architects André and Jean
- **Grand Place** The Grand Place or Grote Markt is the central square of Brussels. The square is the most important tourist destination. It is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Manneken Pis Manneken Pis is a landmark small bronze sculpture in Brussels, depicting a naked little boy urinating into a fountain's basin. It was designed by Hiëronymus Duquesnoy the Elder and put in place in 1618 or 1619.

AMSTERDAM

- Dam Square Dam Square, or simply the Dam is a town square in Amsterdam, the capital of the Netherlands. Its notable buildings and frequent events make it one of the most well-known in the city.
- Zaanse Schans With its traditional houses windmills warehouses and workshops the historic village of Zaanse Schars offers a preserved glimpse of what it was like to live in the Netherlands in the 18th and 19th centuries.

COLOGNE

Gothic Cathedral of Cologne - One of the oldest cities in Germany. Within the most spectacular Gothic cathedral of Cologne has the world's largest church facade, 1996 has been designated as World Heritage Site. It is the main symbol of Cologne, an unofficial symbol.

HEIDELBERG

- **Heidelberg Castle** Is a famous ruin in Germany, is a key Renaissance landmark north of the Alps. Situated 80 meters up the Königstuhl hillside, it overlooks the old downtown.
 - Medieval Town Along the Neckar River, features Hauptstrasse, a mile-long pedestrian street, and is known for its historic and baroque buildings.

TITISEE

- Lake Titisee Lake Titisee in the Black Forest, Baden-Württemberg, covers 1.07 km² and has an average depth of 20 meters. Formed by a glacier, its outflow is the Gutach river
- Black Forest Cuckoo Clock A cuckoo clock, traditionally made in Germany's Black Forest, features a pendulum and strikes the hours with a cuckoo call.

RHINE FALLS

Rhine Falls - The Rhine Falls are Europe's mightiest waterfall. The falls are located at the northernmost edge of Switzerland.

LUCERNE

- **Lion Monument -** The Lion Monument in Lucerne, Switzerland, designed by Bertel Thorvaldsen and carved in 1820–21, honors the Swiss Guards massacred in the 1792 French Revolution. Mark Twain called it "the most mournful and moving piece of stone in the world."
- Wooden Chapel Bridge Is a historic covered wooden bridge with 17th-century paintings, though many were lost in a 1993 fire. Restored, it is Europe's oldest wooden covered bridge and the world's oldest truss bridge.


